REGULATION

Pursuant to Act 47 1990 (effective date April 26, 1990), establishing a Special Fund for the Statewide Supreme Court Law Library System.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following schedule of fines and fees be promulgated and enforced:

1. For overdue State of Hawaii property (books, cassettes, entrance passcards and entrance passkeys) a nonrefundable fine of \$1 per book or cassette and \$5 per entrance passcard or passkey per workday will be charged. All library privileges will be suspended until payment of fine is made in full.

2. A fine of \$25 will be charged for lost or damaged entrance passcard or passkey. This charge will be refunded when a lost passcard or passkey is recovered.

3. A nonrefundable fine of \$25 will be charged for replacement of a borrower's card.

4. For lost or damaged books and cassettes, the replacement cost and handling fee of \$3, or a minimum fine of \$10 and a handling fee of \$3 will be charged.



5. For overdue non-circulating materials borrowed on special loan, a nonrefundable fine of \$5 per one-half hour or fraction thereof per item will be charged. All library privileges will be suspended until payment is made in full.

6. Postage will be charged for items mailed upon request.

7. A charge of \$.10 per photocopy will be assessed for items photocopied. A minimum of \$1 will be charged for photocopying requests.
